History: Examine causes and consequences of a significant historical event (91233)

Evidence

NOTE: As per the Achievement Standard Explanatory Note 3, an 'event' may be discrete, a development or movement over time, or be considered in terms of a person's role.

While accuracy in evidence is desirable (e.g. dates, figures, statistics, quotes, names), the candidate should not be penalised at any grade level unless lack of accuracy detracts from the essay.

A conventional essay structure is required and should be considered in the allocation of the final grade, e.g. whether it enhances or detracts from the clear communication of the causes and consequences.
